* Immaculate Conception of Mary. Teach your child to know and love Mary. As Catholics we believe that Mary was perfectly open to the grace of the Holy Spirit from the moment of her conception. She was chosen to bear Jesus, and thus brought the gift of salvation into human history.

* Reconciliation - Second Rite 7.30pm. This ceremony will be suitable for both children and adults.

* Reconciliation - Second Rite 12.45pm.

- * We light the third candle on the Advent wreath.
- * Advent Blessing for expectant parents at all Masses.

Tues 19 Dec Reconciliation (first rite) 7-8pm.
