Administrative details required for enrolment

When enrolling your child in the Children's Sacramental Program for the first time, i.e. when enrolling your child for the **first sacrament** in the program, please bring to the enrolment desk:

- 1. Completed enrolment form
- 2. Photocopy of baptismal certificate (if not baptised at Chatswood)
- 3. Photograph (ideally 10 x 15 cm) with your child's name on the back for display in the church.
- 4. \$25 to cover cost of books, resources, medals, certificates, etc.

An appointment for an interview is to be arranged at time of enrolment.

N.B. All documentation must be fully completed at the enrolment.

If, for a good reason, you cannot be present on enrolment day, please contact the Coordinator or Parish Office **prior** to the specified date to make alternative arrangements.

When enrolling your child in the Children's Sacramental Program for **subsequent sacraments**, please bring to the enrolment desk the following:

- 1. Completed enrolment form
- 2. \$25 to cover costs of books, resources, medals, certificates, etc.

An appointment for an interview is to be arranged for each sacrament.


